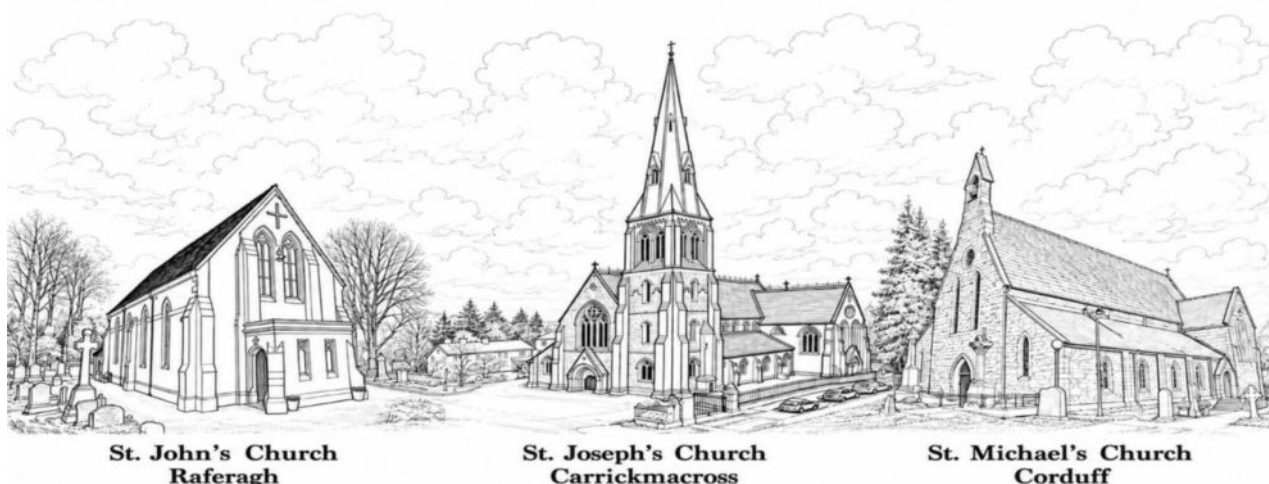

Weekly Reflection.

The grace of forgiveness.

Forgiveness is not easy. There is no more difficult form of giving than forgiving. For some people, forgiveness seems an impossible requirement, because of what they have suffered and the harm that has been done to them. How do you forgive someone who has done something terrible to you or to a member of your family? There are times in our lives when we are not able to forgive someone, especially when the offending person shows no sign of remorse or of wanting to make restitution for the harm done.

Jesus, in today's parable of the unforgiving servant, is suggesting that God's tender, limitless mercy towards us is with a view to our own transformation. To really open our lives to God's limitless mercy is to be transformed by God's love into God's likeness. We all have someone to forgive and we all need to be forgiven by someone. Offering forgiveness to another will never come easy to us; it sometimes comes very slowly. Today's Gospel suggests that the more we appreciate and open ourselves up to the gift of God's limitless forgiveness of us, the freer we will be to pass on that forgiveness to others.

Reflection on Today's Gospel

In today's Gospel, Peter asks Jesus, "How often must I forgive?" Jesus' answer—"not seven times but seventy-seven times"—reminds us that forgiveness is not about keeping count. It is a way of living. The parable of the unforgiving servant shows us the depth of God's mercy. We have received forgiveness far beyond what we could ever earn, yet we can sometimes struggle to extend that same mercy to others. Jesus challenges us to remember that the forgiveness we receive from God should overflow into our relationships.

Forgiving does not mean pretending that hurt never happened. It means choosing not to let resentment have the final word. As we pray the Lord's Prayer, "forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us," may we ask for the grace to forgive generously, patiently, and from the heart.

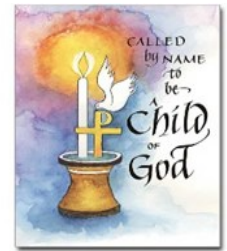

Points to Ponder

Readiness to forgive is taught by many of the great philosophies and religions of the world. Why? Because you can't be happy, or have any sort of inner peace, far less inner joy, if you refuse to forgive. Dwelling on past hurts, nurturing resentment, indulging simmering anger: these things can blight or embitter a person's whole life. Unfortunately though, as all of us know: sometimes forgiveness can seem very difficult indeed, even impossible. Perhaps this is so nowadays more than ever, because contemporary secular culture encourages us to think of ourselves as victims, who have a right to demand compensation and redress.

What though if we find it too hard? What if my brother really hurts or upsets me, and ever continues to do so? What if I have been so deeply wounded by someone that my life is effectively ruined? In that case, let us simply admit the impossibility of our task, and turn to God for help. O God come to my aid, we cry. 'Lord, help me to let go of this. If I can't forgive, then do you forgive in my place. Bless us both, Lord, so that each of us is able to receive the gift of your forgiveness.' We pray, we go to confession, and we come to Mass. Here the love and mercy of Jesus that flows from his sacrificial death are made present, and received in sacramental form. Here supremely we find the grace and strength we need, in order to let go of the debt we are owed: we, who have been redeemed from our own incomparably greater debt, through the blood of Jesus Christ our Lord.

Planning a Baptism

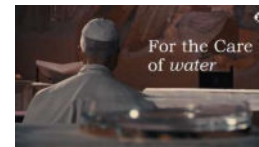

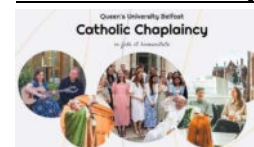
