Cork & Ross Lourdes

parish. They are taking part in the various ceremonies that are part of this and every pilgrimage to Lourdes.

The highpoint of all pilgrimages to Lourdes is the celebration of Mass at the Grotto which for the Cork and Ross pilgrimage will be on Tuesday of this week at 7.30am (Irish time).
