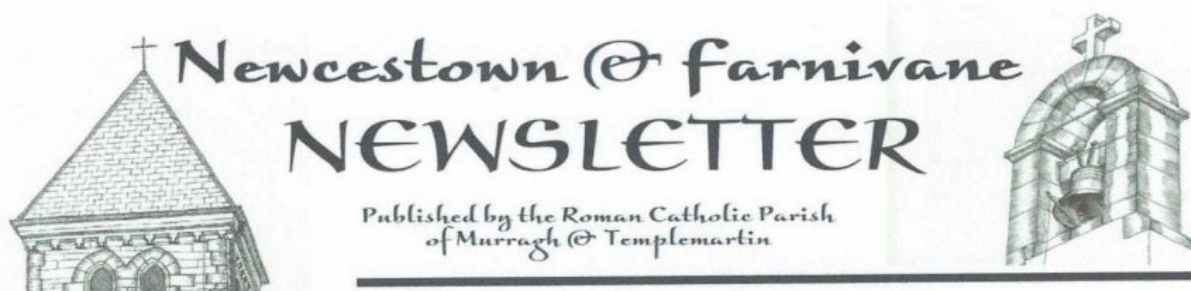

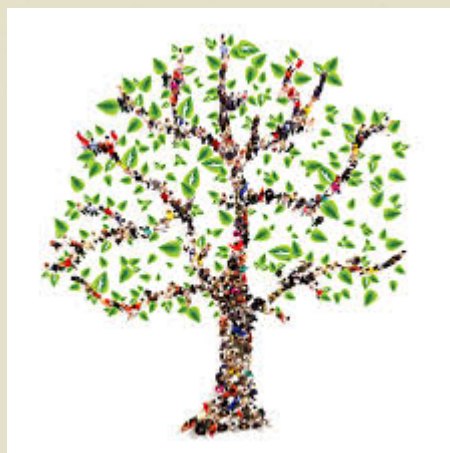


Murragh & Templemartin Parish is setting up a new texting/WhatsApp service to alert parishioners to service changes, deaths, etc.

Searching for Ancestors



In an effort to assist those who wish to trace ancestors from this parish, information from all headstones in St Martin's cemetery, Farnivane, is now available on www.findagrave.com. To access this information, click on the webpage, then click on the tab 'cemeteries', enter Farnivane under Cemetery Name and hit search. This gives a complete list of all those interred in St Martins.

Alternatively, enter the name of the deceased in the search area but be aware that the location of the cemetery is listed as Bandon.

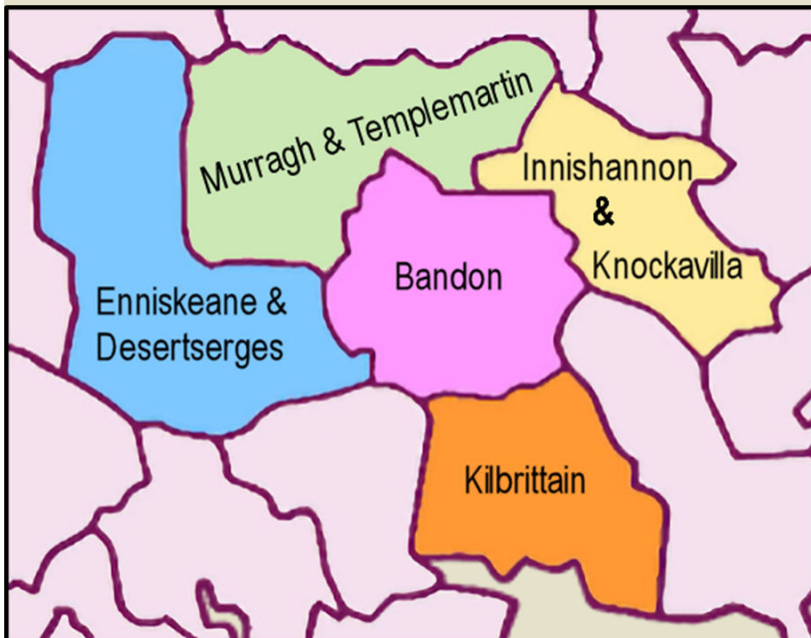
